Chichester District Council Draft Local Plan Key Policies – Preferred Approach
(DLPKP) published in March 2013

As I am sure you will be aware, the above document has been placed into ‘public consultation’ by the District Council. The period closes on 3rd May.

At a recent Parish Council meeting, I requested that our Society, which represents about three quarters of all village residents, join forces with them, to agree what representations should be made.

An initial meeting has now taken place which included the Chairman, Mr Michael Chater OBE. The WIPC have agreed to convene a full meeting on Tuesday 23rd April at which the Society comments set out below will be offered for adoption by them.

My concern is that time is very short and we cannot wait to involve you until after that meeting has taken place.

The Itchenor Society has very serious misgivings about the policies as drafted in the DLPKP.

The issues raised are in need of support at a high level if they are to stand any chance of being taken seriously. Can you help?
